## 1 piece White Cape & 2 pieces Reflectives

- 1.1 WHITE CAPE to clean and ironed before using
- 1.2 The REFLECTIVES of Gold and Silver to determine warm or cool undertone

## 11 pieces Temperature to re-affirm Warm/Cool Undertone

- 1.3. Using 11 pieces of temperature drapes to reconfirm if the client's undertone tend to be warm or cool.

### Note:

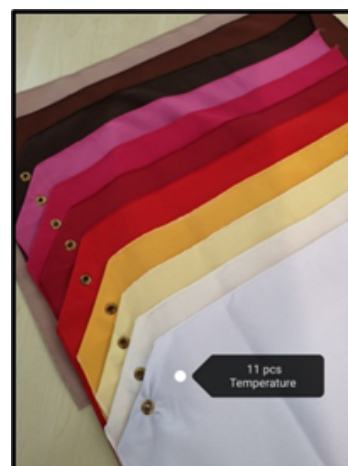
There are 3 shades of Brown :

Cool Brown

Warm Brown

Neutral : Neutral tone in Fawn color

Between Cool/Warm for both skin undertone



## 8 pieces Warm Intensives 8 pieces Cool Intensives

- 2.1. Using EITHER the Cool or Warm Intensity Drapes to determine skin's intensity: Soft (muted/subtle) ~ Medium ~ Bright

### Note:

The last 2 pieces refers to soft and bold patterns.

## 5 pieces Value Drapes 2 pieces Asian Skin Chart

3.1

Using the Asian Chart to determine the contrast level.

Beige for Warm skin tone

Pink for Cool skin tone

Gray Scale at its back can be used for hair color

(if they are black). The beige or pink piece can also be used for hair color that is colored in brown or pink. The difference in numbers of hair and complexion in the Chart define the contrast level as high, medium or low.

3.2

Using the Value Drapes check if skin fit light or deep shades

3.3

Cross over the Value drapes to determine contrast as an ensemble

## 4 Season Pinks for ladies 4 Season Greens for men Individual Seasonal Drapes

4.1

Season Shades.

Green (men) Pink (women)

One Color in 4 different shades to represent 4 different seasons.

a. Spring has pure hues

b. Summer has soft/subtle/muted hue

c. Autumn has toasted hues

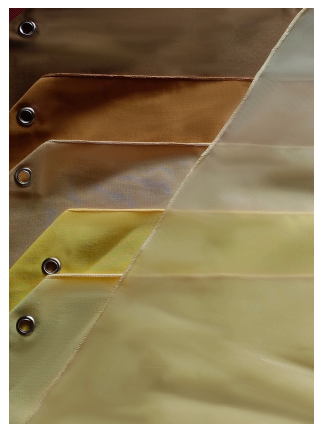
d. Winter has shaded hue (or deep cold hue)

4.2

Present your client's season:

Spring/Summer/Autumn/Winter Drapes

They are currently selected in random colors



## 6 pieces Qualities drapes (in yellow)

5.1

The 6 pieces of Color Qualities denote skin/complexion which is :

Transparent (Washed)

Light & Fair (Tinted)

Smooth/Glowing/Bright (Clear/Pure),

Grey/Ashed (Muted).

Golden/Burnt (Toasted)

Tan & Deep (Shaded)

The Color Wheel : Present Color Theory and Color Harmony for color ensemble



# COLOR CODES

FIT Drapes are made of high quality of TORAY viscose, comb cotton, cotton linen, mostly imported from Japan. Cherry picked for the best selection in its colors for precise color consultation. From time to time, these drapes may be replaced by new color because the existing shade could have been discontinued.

# COLOR CODES

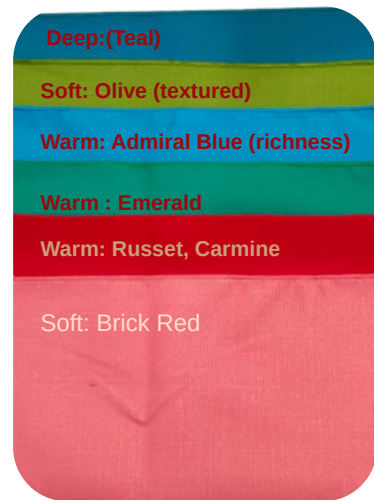
The FIT 78 pieces drapes are washable. Please avoid the eyelets as they may rust due to corrosion of metal and it has an under-pining piece of card for sturdy use. The rings can be used during the consultation or you may choose to remove them for your convenience, especially when using the Value drapes.

These seasonal colors are selected randomly to represent the hues of the season, and not according to 12 Flow System. However, the description on the tones explain if they are Warm, Cool, Soft, Bright, Light or Deep. So please use your analysis techniques to present these drapes.



**Winter**

Winter season has 7 drapes instead of 6. Take a look at the last 2 deep colors, one is Midnight Blue (Indigo) and the other Navy Blue. Indigo is Blue Violet and Navy Blue is Blue Black.



**6 Qualities**

Mainly is used to show the quality of client's skin if they are sensitive, fair, smooth, muted, toasted or shaded (tan)



**Metallics**

4 Metallics soft boards. Your client can put her hands on it to check for the proper jewelry.
